KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Before his tenure as First Secretary of the Embassy of Switzerland in Japan, Fabien was the Director for Asia at the World Economic Forum [WEF], in charge of business development, marketing, fundraising and relationship management for Governments and large corporate houses such as PepsiCo, Reliance Industries, Indian Oil Corporation and Tata Sons. He was responsible for advising and managing relationships with Prime Ministers, Presidents, Ministers and CEOs in Asia, in particular India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Indonesia, Myanmar, Philippines and Malaysia.

At WEF, Fabien was selected as a Global Leadership Fellow, a three-year Master's programme in global leadership, which couples leadership training with in-depth knowledge of industry, civil society, and global and regional governments.

Prior to the WEF, Fabien held some leadership roles in different NGOs, such as the World Business Council for Sustainable Development (Switzerland), the United Nations University (Japan) and the Asia Disaster Reduction Centre (Japan), where he managed projects on sustainable development and capacity building.

Fabien holds a Masters in Global Leadership delivered by the WEF in partnership with INSEAD, University of Pennsylvania Wharton School, Columbia University and London Business School. In addition, Fabien has a Masters of Arts in Political Science from the University of Lausanne, Switzerland, Kyoto University, Japan.

Fabien was born and raised in the French part of Switzerland. He lived in the US and Japan for several years. He travelled to 69 different countries, where he worked as a volunteer on various education and sustainability projects. He speaks French, English, Portuguese, Spanish, German and Japanese. He is currently learning Chinese.
